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- Describe the general practice of the aerodynamic assessment of voice and its use in the evaluation of laryngeal function for voice disorders
- Identify the potential correlates of aerodynamic measures to voice physiology and the rationale for using aerodynamics to inform diagnostic/intervention decisions
- Synthesize the evidence and viewpoints for and against the clinical use of aerodynamics in voice evaluations
